WHY Leave no Trace

The Seven Principles of Leave No Trace provide an easily understood framework of minimum impact practices for anyone visiting the outdoors. Although Leave No Trace has its roots in backcountry settings, the Principles have been adapted so that they can be applied anywhere — from remote wilderness areas, to local parks and even in your own backyard. They also apply to almost every recreational activity. Each Principle covers a specific topic and provides detailed information for minimizing impacts



What is a Level 2 Instructor

The BSA Leave No Trace Level 2 Instructor course includes the full core Leave No Trace Level 2 curriculum, plus Scouting-specific curriculum.

"Much of the curriculum added into a BSA Leave No Trace L2 instructor course is to help graduates become a top-level Leave No Trace resource for their unit, district, and council.

A major goal for our BSA Leave No Trace L2 instructor courses is to graduate effective and active Leave No Trace instructors who will return to their home council and conduct the key Leave No Trace Level 1 courses needed to support their unit, district and council outdoor programs."

Leave No Trace Level 2 Instructor Course April 26 to 28 & May 16 to 19, 2024 Camp Wanocksett 642 Upper Jaffrey Rd Dublin, NH 03444

This course (split over two weekends) trains Scouts and Scouters ages 18 and up to serve as Leave No Trace Educators. Level II Instructors can conduct Leave No Trace Level 1 courses (two-day), and are prepared to teach Leave No Trace skills and workshops.

This invaluable training is recognized and highly regarded throughout the world, especially by the outdoor industry, as well as public and private land management agencies. Successful graduates are certified to train others in Leave No Trace skills and ethics. The Level 2 course provides participants with a comprehensive training in Leave No Trace skills and ethics through practical application in a field-based setting. The first weekend is a mix of classroom and outdoor instruction, introducing the course and schedule, providing in-depth information on the overall Leave No Trace program, how to conduct training courses, and the science behind the Leave No Trace principles. During the second weekend we'll do primitive camping along with hikes each day to explore impacted campsites and trails in Mount Monadnock State Park.

This course is staffed with highly experienced scouting volunteers who are nationally recognized Level 2 Instructors. Participants will learn Leave No Trace techniques through skits, discussions, and hands-on activities. To practice Leave No Trace teaching strategies in a supportive, educational environment, each participant will present a short session or activity focused on the Leave No Trace principles or related topic.

The course costs \$325 (before October 31 2023) and \$375 (November 1 2023 to March 31 2024). This includes facilities fees, meals for both weekends, educational materials, LNT Center for Outdoor Ethics Level 2 registration fee, Leave No Trace Level 2 card from BSA, BSA Leave No Trace Handbook, Leave No Trace L2 patch and lapel and other materials. Participants are also eligible for discounts on Leave No Trace items.
